<u>Sarah Roberts</u>—Author of "Lake Tanganyika: Petrochromis, Gobies, Sand Sifters, and the Odd-Ball Cichlids of Lake Tanganyika" (Longstocking)

Sarah has been a hobbyist for over 20 years, but it wasn't until more than halfway through those 20 years that she found her passion—cichlids from Lake Tanganyika. Born in California, moved to Australia and now residing in Maryland she has always lived near an ocean, which bred her other passion—SCUBA. 
